

"What to Bring" Summer Session

The following items are mandatory for the cadets to bring:

Bedding and Clothes items

- 3 Twin Sets of Fitted and Pillow Case (White only) single bed size.
- 1 Twin Mattress Cover
- 8 Towels and Face Cloths (White Only)
- 4-6 pairs of khaki cargo shorts with belt loops
- 15 pair of Underwear
- 15 Undershirts (Crew Neck, White Only) (No "V" Neck, No Tank Tops)
- 3 pair of Black Dress Socks (Mid Calf length) (No Anklets)
- 12 pair of White athletic socks (Mid Calf length, top approximately 4-6" above ankle) (No anklets, No knee-high')
- Pillow (20 X 26 inches, any firmness)
- Bathrobe
- Long pants/shirt for paintball
- Swim Trunks (Any color, any style)
- 2 pair of Athletic Shoes (One running Pair, and other may be sport specific)
- Shower slippers
- 12 Coat Hangers (Either wood or plastic, Must be all the same)
- Extra blanket, Comforter, or Sleeping bag.

Room Items

- Power Strip- For extra outlets in the room (1 only)
- Cleaning Supplies- Wipes only, no sprays; Glass Cleaner, dust clothes, broom, mop, bucket & scrub brush
- Trash Can (13 Gallon, Tall, Kitchen-style with a supply of Trash Bags)
- Shoe Shining Supplies (Black Kiwi Shoe Polish, cotton cloths or old tee shirts for shining shoes)
- Desk Lamp
- Alarm Clock (Battery operated only)
- Combination Master Lock (For locking the storage under his bed or footlocker)

Personal Items

- Personal Toilet Items-Toilet Tissue, Facial Tissue, Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, Shaving Cream and Razors.
- Body Cleansing Wipes
- BPA safe water bottle
- Re-sealable snack bags (zip lock bags)
- Recommended: Re-resalable or single serving snacks and water bottles

Academic Items

- Spiral Notebooks- One for each subject
- A package of pens (10- 12) (Any style, black ink only)
- A package of pencils (10- 12) (Any style or color)
- Texas Instruments Scientific Calculator (TI 83 or above) for those students taking Geometry or above
- Book Bag or Back Pack
- Lap top if taking if taking math or computer class

The following items are unauthorized for the cadets to bring

- No heat producing items (Coffee pots, hot plates, electric blankets, space heaters etc.)
- No Aerosol Cans (Hairspray, deodorant, air fresheners)
- No protein Powder or Nutritional Supplements
- No Chewing Gum
- No Sunglasses (hats provided)
- New Cadets are not permitted cell phones for the first 2 weeks.
