- That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side."
- Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him.
- ³⁷ A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped.
- ³⁸ Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion.
 - The disciples woke him and said to him,
 - "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"
- He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Ouiet! Be still!"
 - Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.
- ⁴⁰ He said to his disciples,
 - "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"
- ⁴¹ They were terrified and asked each other,
 - "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!" Mark4:35-41


Paul faced a crisis of division in the church at Corinth

- ⁵ What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe-- as the Lord has assigned to each his task.
- ⁶ I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow.
- So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.
- ⁸ The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and each will be rewarded according to their own labor.
- ⁹ For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building.
- By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as an expert builder, and someone else is building on it.
 - But each one should build with care.
- ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

Their understanding of church was both too high & too low

1 Corinthians 3:5-11, 16-17

- Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?
- 17 If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.
