2.00 ACADEMICS

2.01 INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

The 3rd term examination for JS1, JS2, SS1 and SS2 was held between Friday, 29th June and Thursday, 4th July, 2022.

2.03 UNIFIED TERTIARY MATRICULATION EXAMINATION (UTME)

Forty-one (41) of the graduating students sat for the computer-based Test of the 2022 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) at different CBT centres within Ikorodu on 6th and 7th May 2022.

Ayuba Mathias had the highest score of 329 marks. 97% of them scored above 200 while only 3% scored below 200. The result is impressive and we are grateful to God for the achievement.

2.04 WASSCE/NECO & BECE EXAMINATION

Preparation for the external examinations (WASSCE, NECO, and BECE) was in top gear all through the session. WASSCE has ended, and we are waiting for the results while NECO is ongoing. BECE examinations have been concluded, results have not been released yet.
