Leadership Education Training - JROTC

Fishburne is one of only a few schools that offers a summer LET course. A cooperative venture between the US Army and high schools, this curriculum focuses on character education, student achievement, wellness, leadership, and diversity. This course also includes field learning experiences, including a visit to the Virginia Military Institute's George Marshall Museum and Archives.

Flight Training Program

Earn Credits towards Graduation

Academic classes are offered as full day classes for students who wish to take the class for the first time to gain credit. Classes are offered as half day courses for students looking to retake a class in order to boost their GPA or earn a passing grade. All credits will transfer back to the student's home school.

Courses Offered:

- Algebra (Pre, I, II), Geometry
- World and US History
- English, grades 7-11.
- Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry
- Spanish (I and II)
- JROTC (I and II)

**All classes are offered at the standard level. No Advanced Placement, honors, or Dual Enrollment courses.

Electives are also offered over the summer. All electives are half day courses.

Electives Offered:

- Outdoor Adventure (\$150)
- Intro to Coding
- 3D Model and Design
- Introduction to Cyber Security
- SAT Prep (Rising 10th and 11th graders)
- Tech Skills
- Study Skills (Rising 7th, 8th, and 9th graders)

All classes require a minimum of 5 students.
