



“What to Know & Bring” Full Session SY-2020-2021

Although the items listed below can be obtained either from the school’s Cadet Store or from stores in the City of Waynesboro, it is advisable for all Cadets to bring the following:

- Wristwatch – Inexpensive
- Hair Comb or Brush
- Shoeshine Supplies (Black Kiwi polish, shoe brush, cotton cloths; old tee shirts are great)
- Underwear and Undershirts (15 sets minimum, shirts white/round neck)
 - Note: undershirt sleeves must not be so large as to hang lower than a short-sleeved dress shirt.

- Black Socks (15 pair minimum)
- Bed Sheets (3) sets white only twin size
- 1 Twin Size Mattress Cover
- Pillow (1) Standard Size
- Power Strip for extra electrical outlets in room (no extension cords)
- Supply of personal toilet articles (toothbrush and toothpaste, toilet tissue, facial tissue, soap, shampoo, deodorant, shaving gel or butter, razors (No aerosols, Alcohol free mouthwash only)
- Body and Face Towelettes
- Cleaning Supplies – No sprays, No Windex, wipes only (glass cleaner, dust cloths, broom, mop, scrub brush)
- Trash Can (13-gallon tall kitchen style with supply of trash bags)
- Backpack/Book Bag
- Supply of Spiral Notebooks, Paper, Pencils, Pens
- Khaki trousers (1 pair)
- Collared Polo-style shirt (plain/solid in color) (1)
- Athletic Socks (15 pair minimum white, crew or mid-calf)
- Bath Towels (12, white only)
- Bathrobe
- Athletic Supporters or Compression Shorts (3)
- Swim Trunks
- Shower Shoes or Slippers
- Athletic and Gym Shoes (2 Pair – 1 running, 1 pair may be sport specific)
- Desk Lamp (not larger than 16” tall)
- Alarm Clock
- Coat Hangers (plastic, must all be the same)
- Combination Lock (for locking storage unit under bed or footlocker)
- Snacks/Drinks (Water/Gatorade/Juice, re-sealable or single serve snacks; no protein powder/supplements)

- Calculators for Math Classes

- Geometry and Algebra II – Texas Instrument 84 or better
- Algebra II w/ Trigonometry and Precalculus – Texas Instrument 84 or better. IT Nspire CX CAS recommended
- AP Calculus and AP Statistics – TI Nspire CX or TI Nspire CX CAS
- Word processing device that can use Google and Microsoft Office Software

Cadets will only be allowed 2 electronic devices, not to include cellphone.

The following optional items are recommended for the student’s comfort and use:

- Extra Blanket (solid color)
- USB Flash Drive for saving work on computers
- Laptop or Tablet for homework
- Gaming system, up to a 24” inch flat screen tv/monitor. (New cadets are not allowed these items until training is complete. Upon graduation from new cadet status, cadets will be allowed to have electronics. These items can and will be temporarily confiscated if the student is not performing to his potential.

Rooms:

Cadet Rooms are 11’7” W x 15’3” L and are shared by two Cadets. All electronic equipment and music or games must be indelibly marked with the cadet’s name and number and must fit on the cadet’s desk.

While Fishburne Military School does everything within its power to ensure the safety of each student’s personal property, the school cannot accept any responsibility in this area. All Cadets must secure any personal items of value in their lockable storage area. Cadets must provide their own combination lock.

Phones:

- VoIP – Voice over Internet Protocol phones have been issued to each cadet. The phone will stay with the cadet even if the cadet changes rooms, ensuring his extension stays the same.
- Parents can call the main Fishburne phone number 540-946-7700 and then dial the phone extension. (Extension is displayed in the upper left-hand corner of the phone).
- Cadets must setup their voicemail greeting and password. To check voicemail, press the envelope button. The initial password for each phone is the same as the extension.
- Phones will be returned to IT staff at the end of the school session and inspected for damage. Damage will be reported and charged at the rate listed in the section – Property Damage.

Note: When you set up your voice mail greeting, use appropriate language. Inappropriate or insulting greetings will result in the loss of your private phone privilege.

The use of a phone in your room is a privilege and can be revoked at any time.

Phone times: The phone system is placed on a timer. Phone times will be established at the beginning of the school year and communicated to parents. Please keep in mind they may be changed at any time; however, you may reach your cadet through the emergency number (24
