## Fishburne Military School

The Leadership for Life Scholarship is a merit-based award given to recognize and encourage academic achievement and leadership potential. This scholarship is intended for students entering FMS who desire to pursue an education in a military structured environment, have demonstrated superior academic excellence, and intend to become a full contributing member to the Fishburne Military School Corps of Cadets.

### Criteria

1. Rising 7-11 grader, seeking enrollment for the **2020-2021 School Year (New students only)**.
2. Demonstrated high academic achievement as evidenced by a **GPA of 3.0 or above**.
3. **Strong communication skills** demonstrated during an on campus, in person interview.
4. Shows ability and interest to be an **active participant** in the JROTC program, athletics, and clubs throughout the school year.
5. Indicates **desire to attend** Fishburne Military School and the intention to embody the Fishburne Honor Code to become an exemplary member of the Corps of Cadets.

### How to Apply

1. Complete and submit an application form online located at <https://www.fishburne.org/admissions-apply>.
2. Schedule an **On Campus Interview** through the admissions office
3. Once records have been received and interview completed, the Admissions Committee will review all information to make a recommendation for admission and receipt of the Leadership for Life Scholarship.
4. Families will then submit a **financial aid application** with a copy of their **2019 1040** to the FMS business office. A financial package for the school year will then be offered to the family. The Leadership for Life merit scholarship will be given **in addition to any financial aid** the family qualifies for.
5. The Leadership for Life Scholarship is **not a full ride scholarship**. The amount offered is contingent upon the strength of applicant and family's financial situation.
