Choreographer

Emmy Award-winning choreographer and performer **Emilio Dosal** has built an extraordinary career spanning more than a decade across film, television, live performance, and some of the world's biggest stages.

Most recently, Emilio served as **Associate Choreographer on Universal Pictures' blockbuster film adaptations *Wicked* (2024) and *Wicked: For Good* (2025)**, directed by Jon M. Chu. Continuing his work in major musical productions, Emilio recently completed **Disney's *Descendants: Wicked Wonderland* (2026)**, further establishing him as a sought-after creative voice in dance and movement for film and television.

Emilio first gained international recognition as a member of **I.aM.mE**, winners of MTV's *America's Best Dance Crew* Season 6. Following the win, he performed internationally with the crew before going on to work with artists including **Far East Movement, LMFAO, and Justin Bieber**.

His film career began to expand in 2013 when he was cast as a lead dancer in *Step Up All In*. The following year, Emilio competed on FOX's *So You Think You Can Dance* Season 11, advancing to the **Top 10** and joining the show's 77-city North American tour.

Emilio went on to perform on some of the world's largest concert stages. He toured internationally with **Selena Gomez** on her *Revival Tour*, joined **Derek and Julianne Hough** as a lead dancer on *Move Beyond Live on Tour*, and performed in 113 shows around the world with **Katy Perry** on her *Witness: The Tour*.

As his career evolved from performer to choreographer, Emilio became **Associate Choreographer on Jon M. Chu's *In the Heights*** and later choreographed the Disney+ original film *Sneakerella*, directed by Elizabeth Allen Rosenbaum. His work on *Sneakerella* earned Emilio his first **Children's & Family Emmy Award for Outstanding Choreography**.

Emilio continued expanding his film credits with choreography for Matthew Vaughn's action feature *Argylle* before joining the creative team behind *Wicked* and *Wicked: For Good* as Associate Choreographer.

From world tours and television to award-winning choreography and major motion pictures, Emilio continues to evolve as an artist while bringing his distinctive movement vocabulary, versatility, and performance experience to every project. His career reflects a commitment not only to pushing the boundaries of dance and choreography, but also to inspiring the next generation of artists to pursue their ambitions.
