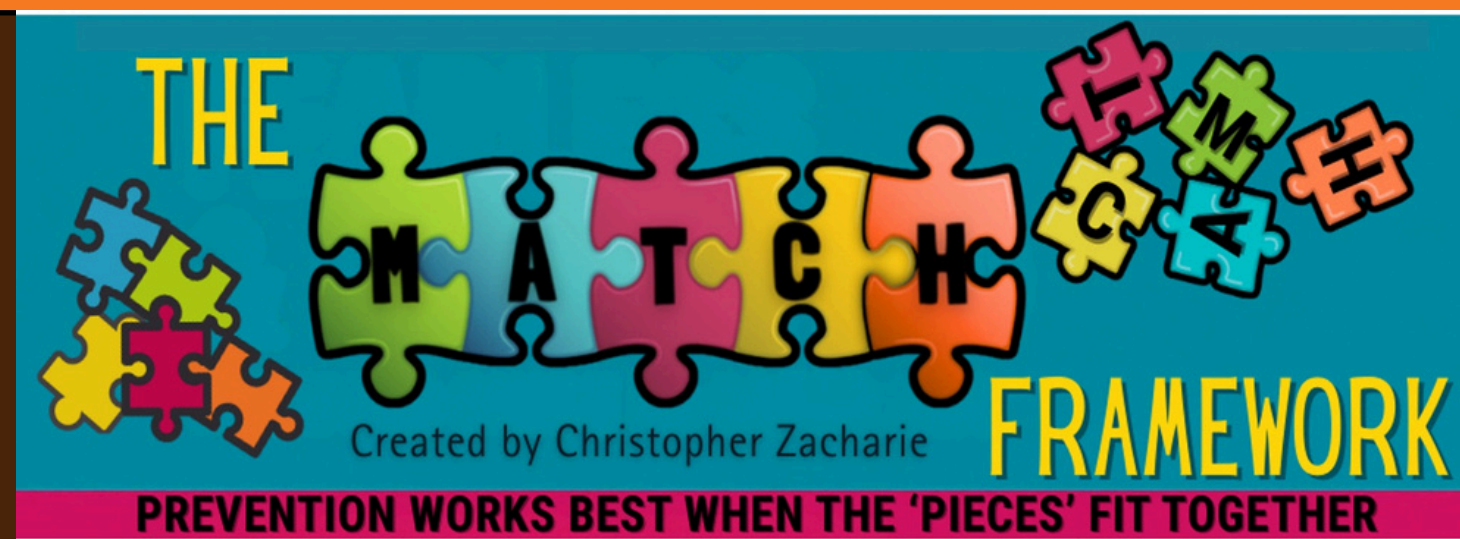

WHAT-IF SCENARIO GUIDE

The Silent Room

FACILITATOR ACTION:

Pivot to a low-stakes metaphor.

SCRIPT:

"Looks like we're in a waiting room right now. Let's shift gears. Share one 'weather report' for your week."

PRO TIPS:

- Don't call anyone out by name
- Lower stakes first, then build back up
- Model vulnerability yourself—share your own weather

The Over-Share

FACILITATOR ACTION:

Validate and redirect using the Gatekeeper.

SCRIPT:

"I want to pause you there. To keep our gates secure in this group setting, let's bookmark this for a 1-on-1 chat."

PRO TIPS:

- Affirm their trust in the group
- Never shame the disclosure
- Follow up privately after the session

WHAT-IF SCENARIO GUIDE

The Boundary Pusher

FACILITATOR ACTION:

Re-anchor to the framework firmly.

SCRIPT:

"In our café, everyone deserves good service. Joking about orders risks an allergic reaction. Let's reset."

PRO TIPS:

- Stay calm and grounded in the metaphor
- Don't escalate emotionally
- If behavior continues, apply Yellow Protocol

The Flooded Learner

FACILITATOR ACTION:

De-escalate without isolating.

SCRIPT:

"Looks like a storm rolled in. Storms are allowed here. Let's drop our anchors and just watch the rain for a minute."

PRO TIPS:

- Give them space to breathe, not exit
- Don't draw group attention to them
- Assess privately—escalate to Red if needed

FACILITATOR SPARKS

Video Training Outline – Key Reminders

01

The Weather Spark

Your goal isn't to teach psychology – it's to teach meteorology. Keep it concrete. Ask, "Is it raining or just cloudy?"

02

The Café Spark

The Consent Café can bring up giggles. Lean into the character. The more seriously you treat the menu, the safer they feel.

03

The Data Spark

Don't frame the post-assessment as a test. Frame it as their receipt for the day – to see what they "bought into."

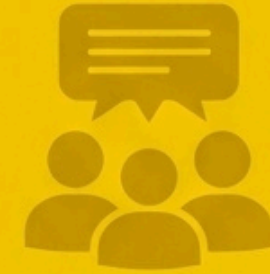
