Dave's Dive Service performs underwater maintenance for work and pleasure craft at marinas around the greater Puget Sound area. Primarily the work involves routine replacement of zincs, cleaning hulls and running gear. Employee will assist with loading the dive cart with appropriate tools, parts and dive equipment and getting it to and from your vehicle to the work sites. Employee will be expected to carefully follow all instructions to the letter. All the work takes place in shallow protected waters. The work does not require advanced diving skills or commercial dive certification. Starting out, a candidate in training will typically meet at our office in Tacoma to obtain work and supplies for the day. Trainees will be working closely with a senior diver assisting until they can work independently. Employee will need reliable transportation to and from job sites. Employee will also be expected to provide and maintain their own dive gear. Work starts at 8am and is usually 8-to-10-hour days. Be prepared for working in adverse weather conditions. The work can be tedious and physically taxing and requires a high level of fitness and strength.
