WELCOME:

The members of the ILLINOIS TREKKERS invite you, your family, and your friends to join us for a walk through Lebanon, Illinois. Lebanon is a city in St. Clair County, Illinois. Like many other places in "Little Egypt" or Southern Illinois, Lebanon was named after the Eastern Mediterranean country of the same name. Lebanon is home to McKendree University, the oldest college in Illinois.

VOLKSMARCH: A Volksmarch is literally a "folks walk" or a walk for the people. It is a self-paced walk for all to enjoy. The purpose of a Volksmarch is to encourage physical fitness, promote fellowship and to enjoy the outdoors.

TRAIL INFORMATION:

Saturday, October 1, 2022, starting at the Lebanon Visitors Center 221 W. St. Louis Street, Lebanon, Illinois.

START/FINISH POINT AND TIMES: Start anytime between 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Walk or run at your own pace. You must be finished by 2:00 p.m.

DISTANCE: 5k, 10k, 15k & 20k walks will be offered. The first 5k loop is on various surfaces (streets or roads) by historic and residential areas. Some streets may not have sidewalks and some sidewalks may be uneven. The second 5k loop goes through the McKendree University campus and out to St. Joseph Catholic Church Cemetery. Wheelchairs and strollers would be able to navigate with some difficulty on the historic walk. Adequate street parking is available. One may want to come early due to the Fall Festival. Additional parking may be found at the Grade School and then walk 3 blocks to Start Point.

TRAIL: The trail is rated 1A (1+) 3 small hills.

REFRESHMENTS: Water will be provided at the Visitor Center for purchase. Restrooms are available at the start/finish point.

REGISTRATION: Everyone is welcome to participate in this event

for a fee of \$3. An adult must accompany children age 12 and under. All participants must check in at the registration table and receive a Start Card. The Start Card must be carried on the walk. Start Cards remain the property of the Illinois Trekkers and must be turned in at the finish point at the end of the walk. There is no refund for monies paid. Event will take place regardless of weather. Pets are welcome and must be kept on a leash and you must pick up after your pet.
