Walking Weekend Details

All of these 5 walks will be available using the Online Start Box beginning in April. We will have normal registration and a physical stamp for these walks during this weekend only!

But, if you prefer to do the walks on your own, you will be able to register for all 5 walks on Friday April 29th at the Cameron/DeKalb County walk and on Saturday, April 30th at the Bethany, MO walk. This walk is located on a paved trail that goes through beautiful forests and great views of a gorgeous lake. Note: This trail is a 5K trail. If you are doing the 10K you will walk this trail twice. Restrooms available at a few spots on the trail.
