# CERTIFICATE OF OPERATIONAL AUTHORITY

This document serves as a formal declaration of operational scope and professional mandate for the organization identified as:

#### **DAPA-GOV**

(Digital Assets Protection Authority)

#### 1. Establishment and Identity

DAPA-GOV is a digital assets protection body, operative since the September 1st 2017, established for the purpose of providing specialist services in the fields of:

- Blockchain analysis
- Cyber-fraud investigation
- Forensic chain-analysis

The Authority functions as a specialized entity focusing on identifying, tracing, analyzing, and reporting digital-asset activities for investigative, compliance, and forensic purposes.

## 2. Leadership

The Chief Executive Officer of DAPA-GOV is Mr. Harvey Vermont, appointed to office on the 1st of September, 2017.

The Chief Executive Officer exercises executive oversight of the Authority's operational, analytical, and investigative functions in accordance with professional and regulatory standards applicable to digital-asset monitoring and cyber-forensic disciplines.

#### 3. Registered Seat

The principal seat of operation is located in **Luxembourg** at the following address:

This site constitutes the primary operational center of the Authority's administrative and professional activities.

### 4. Authorised Scope of Operation

DAPA-GOV is authorised to conduct its services **across any jurisdiction**, provided that such operations are undertaken pursuant to a lawful contractual engagement with recognised local entities, including but not limited to:

- Government institutions
- Financial authorities
- Law enforcement agencies
- Regulatory or compliance bodies
- Corporate or institutional clients

Its cross-border operational model is based on contractual authorization, technical expertise, and international cooperation standards in the domains of digital assets and cyber investigation.

#### 5. Functional Mandate


The Authority's services include, but are not limited to:

- 1. The tracing and mapping of blockchain transactions
- 2. The identification of digital wallets and transactional patterns
- 3. The detection and reconstruction of illicit or irregular digital-asset movements
- 4. The provision of forensic reports for legal, regulatory, or investigative use
- 5. The support of recovery or enforcement proceedings involving digital assets

These functions may be exercised in support of legal inquiries, regulatory reviews, or institutional investigations related to crypto-assets and blockchain-based systems.
