Each exhibit is to consist of the following:

- 1. A dish of 5 onions of any variety.
- 2. The onions may be grown from either seed or sets.
- 3. The onions may be Autumn or Spring Sown. The variety to be correctly named.
- 4. Each onion must be tied and weigh not more than 450 grams.
- 5. The onions to be harvested and have clear unbroken skins.
- 6. The produce must be the property of and grown by the exhibitor.
- 7. A special qualifying class will be held at selected shows. Two exhibits may qualify for the Final, if the Judges agree that the standard is high enough.
- 8. The competition will be judged as follows:
 - (a) Condition/Quality: 25 points
 - (b) Uniformity & Shape: 25 points
 - (c) Size/Weight: 10 points
 - (d) Colour: 10 points
 - (e) Overall presentation/attractiveness: 10 points
- 9. Judges decision will be final at all stages of the competition.
- 10. Exhibits are displayed at owner's risk.

It is the policy of Gort & District Show Company Ltd., (hereafter referred to as "The Show") to conform to the requirements of the Safety, Health and Welfare Act. The Show has a general duty of care and its objective is to provide as safe a place of work as is reasonably practicable. To achieve this aim requires the commitment of all Management and Staff. The implementation of the policies together with responsibilities, are defined in the remainder of the Safety Statement.

The Show will seek advice from and provide guidance in Safety, Health and Welfare matters towards members of the public where necessary.

The Show would like to bring to the attention of all its Committee members, stewards and helpers, to all exhibitors/competitors and to you, the general public that we seek your full co-operation in taking heed to any notices or requests made by any of its safety team. It is only by your co-operation and our commitment to improving safety standards that everyone can enjoy an accident-free day.

The Staff, whether voluntary or otherwise, must also recognise that they, too, have a responsibility, under the Act, to conserve safe working practices and The Show expects full co-operation from them in this regard. It is The Show's objective, by having a Safety Team to look at all sections and to see what safety measures (if any) need to be taken and to remove any risks of accidents. In this way The Show will be a safe place and far less likely to cause accidents and the pain and suffering that goes with them. Areas that are designated unsafe are within roped arenas, e.g. show rings. All **"Out of Bounds"** signs must be observed.

Gort & District Show Rules:

All Exhibits must be made/ produced by the Exhibitor and produced/ grown since last year's show.

1. The decision of the Judge will be final.

 The exhibitor receiving the largest number of points in a Section will be regarded the most successful exhibitor in that section; three points being awarded to 1st Prize winner in each class, two points to 2nd and one point to 3rd.

When exhibitors are awarded the same number of points, the exhibitor with the greatest number of prizes will then be considered the most successful. If in the case that these are both equal, the person with the most First places will be deemed the winner. If this is the same, a joint winner will be declared.

- All entries must be on the Official Entry Form and must be declared to the Entries Secretary by 4pm on Saturday 26th July 2025. All Indoor Exhibits must be clearly marked with the relevant Class and Entry Number on Show Day.
- The Committee will not be responsible for loss, theft or accidents etc., of any kind which may occur to Exhibitors, Visitors, Exhibits or otherwise.
- 5. Vases, display frames etc., must be supplied by the Exhibitor where necessary.
- 6. Showroom opens at 6.00 p.m. until 9.00 p.m. the day prior to the Show for non-perishable indoor exhibits only and <u>9.00 a.m. until 10.00</u> <u>a.m.</u> on show day for all types of exhibits. All exhibits must be in place by 10.00 a.m. Judging commences at 10.00 a.m. sharp.
- 7. Exhibits may not be removed before 5.00 p.m. and all exhibits must be removed by 6.00 p.m.

8. The show area will be closed to Exhibitors and general public while judging is in progress from 10am.

9. Perpetual cups and trophies, on presentation, must be signed for by the recipient in acceptance of responsibility. Such cups and trophies cannot be won outright and are to be returned to the Organising Secretary by **12th July** of the year following the show.

10. Food vans, hawkers, traders selling illegal items, or unauthorised traders who have not received written consent from Gort Show Company Ltd., are not allowed on the Show Grounds. Consent must be produced on the day for entry.

11. Any person who interferes in any way, i.e. by action, discourtesy, disobedience etc., with a judge, steward or official will, at the discretion of the Show Committee, receive a written warning as to their behaviour and may forfeit any prize money he/she may have won in any section of the Show.

If there should be any further re-occurrence of a similar incident involving the same person/s, the Show committee will bar that person/s from entering or exhibiting at the Gort Show for a period that will be determined by the Show Committee.

- 12. All "out of bounds" notices must be observed and adhered to by exhibitors and the general public at all times.
- 13. The above rules are for the benefit of exhibitors and the general public and will be rigidly enforced.
