Through interactive sessions, translational science, and strategic networking, participants engage across the full continuum of innovation: from bench to bedside to policy.

WHSI champions scientific excellence, early-stage innovation, and impactful collaboration. It is an innovation-forward, science-driven summit where translation and impact are at the center of every session.
