

Fireplace Instructions

We are excited that you are here and able to enjoy our wood-burning fireplace, it is one of our favorite features! Here are some basics on using and enjoying this feature safely.

- **Leave Damper Open**
 - This is to ensure the smoke goes out of the chimney and not into the home.
 - It is set to remain open, please **do not** close it for the next guest.
 - If smoke enters the home, discontinue building the fire.
- **Only use 1 or 2 small logs at a time**
 - This ensure the blaze and smoke output remains manageable
 - Do not burn other items beyond kindling and logs.
- **Close chain-grate once the fire is lit**
 - This keeps sparks inside the fire area
- **Ensure embers are cold before leaving the home**
 - Separating the logs from each other will help put-out the fire more quickly.
 - Please keep all logs/ flammable materials within the fireplace.
- **Scoop all ash and remnants into the bucket**
- **Dispose of *cold* ashes in the dumpster**
 - Warm ashes or embers will cause a dumpster fire

In Case of Emergency, use Fire Extinguisher
